Local Group Sessions for ECTs and Mentors

The first Local Group Sessions for Mentors and ECTs have now been completed and we have received some excellent feedback from our attendees which we will take on board for developmental discussions and future deliveries:

Headlines:

98% of ECTS and **94%** of Mentors felt the organisation of the training session was 'good' or 'very good'

93% of ECTS and **89%** of Mentors rated the quality of the training as 'good' or 'very good'

92% of ECTS and **89%** of Mentors 'agreed' or 'strongly agreed' that they would be able to apply their learning to their practice.

The Regional Conferences for ECTs and Mentors will take place online in January 2022. Dates and programmes will be shared as soon as they are confirmed.

Full funding for all teachers now available

DfE funding is available for up to 3 years to provide access to NPQs for all teachers employed in state funded schools and state funded organisations that offer 16 -19 places in England, to support teachers and pupils following the disruption to learning faced as a result of COVID-19. We would strongly urge you to make your application to guarantee funding.
