ECF Funding:

Update on funding arrangements for ECF will follow in January. The headline figures are: In Year 1 ECTs receive funding for 10% off timetable.

In Year 2 the new funding arrangement is the following:

- Funding for 5% off timetable in the second year of induction for all ECTs
- Funding for time for Mentors to spend with ECTs in the second year of induction

DfE funding is available for up to the next 3 years to provide access to NPQs for all.

Cohort 1b February 2022

- Applications are now being taken for all NPQ Programmes for both Teach First and Church of England. All applications should be made through our website.
- Closing date for applications for cohort 1b is 7th January 2022 for both Church of England and Teach First.

We would strongly urge you to make your application NOW to guarantee funding.
