Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Teaching School Hub Update

Welcome to the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Teaching School Hub update. The Hub is for all schools in the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough area and includes all primary, secondary, special and AP schools. We are working with partners and the LA to deliver teacher development from EYFS to KS5.

I hope you are finding the information included in our updates helpful in your preparation for the next academic year. Please read through the information to ensure you are up to date with what the hub can offer and how we can support you in delivering the ECF and NPQ programmes in your schools.

Early Career Framework (ECF):

Numbers for the ECF Programme continue to increase throughout the region with over 115 Schools expressing an interest and informing us of the <u>270</u> Early Career Teachers (ECTs) they wish to enrol with us for the ECF programme, which is to be delivered in partnership with Education Development Trust (EDT). Once again may I express my huge thanks to the schools who have registered an interest with us. We will be contacting you shortly to ensure we have the names of all ECTs who should be included in the programme.

Action reminder:

Essential actions to be ready for September 2021

Once the DfE Portal re-opens this week they will contact your Induction Tutors to remind them to input all details of your ECTs and Mentors to ensure they are able to access the learning materials from the beginning of September 2021. If you have ECTs and mentors but have yet to complete the required registration please follow the 4 steps and links below. (Further details can be found on the <u>C&P TS Hub temporary website</u>).

- 1) Register with the Hub please use the link to access the simple online Expression of interest form so that we can provide you with support and guidance for your trainees.
- <u>2)</u> Register with EDT please ensure you choose <u>Delivery Partner</u>: 'Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Teaching School Hub' from the drop down to ensure that you

- 3) Register with DfE ensure you choose 'Use an approved training provider' so you can access the Full Induction Programme through the Teaching School Hub

Facilitator Training

Facilitator training has commenced with 2 sessions last week and a further 2 this week. Thank you to everyone who has offered to share their expertise and services in this role. For anyone who is unable to attend the scheduled sessions, a recording of the training will shortly be made available by EDT.

Facilitators will be paired to enable a collaborative delivery of the training materials to both ECTs and Mentors. Details of pairings will be distributed before the end of term.

Lynne Birch, Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Teaching School Hub Leader will be inviting you to attend a brief 'virtual' introductory meeting prior to the end of term, details of which will be forwarded to you during the coming week.

ECT and Mentor Training Dates

We are working with local Schools to finalise the training dates for both the ECTs and mentors for Term 1 and the Conferences (Regional Training sessions) in term 2 and hope to have these with you by the end of this term. Please bear with us as we have 24 groups to finalise.

Year 1 have 2 face to face Local group sessions for <u>ECTs</u>, together with 1 Regional Training Session. There will also be two scheduled <u>Mentor training sessions</u> during Year 1.

NPQs:

Last week the DfE announced details of their funding and eligibility criteria in respect of the new NPQ programme. Details can be found on the attached document.

Eligibility criteria for funding includes schools that are within the top 30th percentile in relation to pupils on pupil premium as of the end of the previous academic year and a list of these schools has been provided by the DfE.
